Grove City College Wolverines [4-5 / 3-2 PAC]

GAME TEN

Thiel and Grove City hook up for the 96th time on Saturday in what will be the 2009 season finale for both schools. At stake is the coveted Mercer County Cup, which will be awarded for the 26th time.

The Wolverines have won the series' previous two meetings by the slimmest of margins – 20-14 in 2008 and 14-13 in 2007. Thiel, however, has won five of the last eight contests by a combined 179-85 margin.

Kurt Reiser is the seventh man to coach the Tomcats in a Cup game; while Grove City head man, Chris Smith, has prowled the Wolverine sidelines for each of the 25 previous clashes for the Cup.

For the second consecutive week, two of the Presidents' Athletic Conference's top quarterbacks will square off when the Blue and Gold take the field.

Thiel senior QB **Willie Bova** completed a school record 37 passes for 350 yards and a touchdown last week against Waynesburg. Along the way, Bova picked up the Thiel career records for passing yards with 5,415 in addition to the mark for total offense with 5,763. Already the holder of three of Thiel's six career passing records, Bova enters the game needing just seven attempts to earn the College's mark for career attempts.

Bova's most reliable target – senior WR **Brendan Taylor** – hauled in a Thiel record 17 passes for 216 yards last week in becoming just the third Tomcat to earn 1,000 receiving yards in a season.

On the visitors' side, Grove City signal-caller Andrew DiDonato will play his final collegiate game, with accomplishments mirroring those of his Thiel counterpart. The Wolverine QB holds the Grove City career records for passing yards, completions, attempts, and touchdowns.

Defensively, senior MLB **Sam Swartzfager** is coming on strong for the Tomcats. After leading Thiel with 12 tackles a week ago, Swartzfager has catapulted into seventh place among the league's top tacklers with 67.

The Wolverines are paced by the PAC's top tackler in Jason Ferguson, who has registered an impressive 93 stops this season.

- 9 The Tomcats are +9 in the turnover department this season - second only to Geneva in the PAC.
- 8 RB **Ross Gargano** has a team-leading eight touchdowns heading into week 11.
- 7 WR **Brendan Taylor** enters today's game only seven receptions away from tying the Thiel season record with 90 receptions.
- 6 K **John Madeline** is tied for first in the PAC in field goals made with six after booting a 35-yarder last week.
- 5 WR **Brendan Taylor** also enters today's contest ranked fifth in DIII in catches per game (9.22)
- 4 DE **Tim Taylor**'s four forced fumbles tops the league and ranks seventh in the country. The DIII forced fumbles leader has seven.

Last time out...

A pair of Thiel players combined to set four records Saturday, but it wasn't enough to pull out the win, as the Tomcats fell, 38-17, to Waynesburg University in Presidents' Athletic Conference football action.

Senior quarterback **Willie Bova (Port Allegany, Pa./Port Allegany)** completed a school record 37 passes for 350 yards and a touchdown in the contest. Along the way, Bova picked up the Thiel career records for passing yards with 5,415 in addition to the mark for total offense with 5,763.

His favorite target on the day – senior WR **Brendan Taylor (Girard, Pa./Girard)** – hauled in a Thiel record 17 passes for 216 yards.

Taylor also became just the third Tomcat to earn 1,000 receiving yards in a season.

Despite Thiel's impressive aerial assault, the home-standing Yellow Jackets outgained the 449-to-372 en route to its fifth win of the season.

Waynesburg quarterback Brad Dawson went 23-for-37 for 306 yard and three scores on the day.

Senior linebacker **Sam Swartzfager (Shipperville, Pa./Keystone)** had his best game of the season, recording 12 tackles (nine solo) including two sacks and a tackle-for-loss for a combined 25-loss.

Waynesburg jumped out to a 10-0 first quarter lead before yielding its first points of the game in the form of a second-quarter **John Madeline (Hubbard, Ohio/Hubbard)** field goal.

The Yellow Jackets tacked on 21 points before the Tomcats managed to answer with its first visit to the end zone in the third quarter.

In what was undoubtedly Thiel's offensive play of the day, Bova and Taylor teamed up for a 70-yard pass to make the score 38-10 in favor of the Jackets.

Thiel's **Ross Gargano (Sharon, Pa./Kennedy Catholic)** scored his team-leading eighth touchdown of the season in the fourth quarter to close out the scoring and set the final score.

Bova earns second PAC honor

For the second time this season, Thiel senior quarterback **Willie Bova** has been cited as the Presidents' Athletic Conference Offensive Player of the Week.

In Thiel's, 38-14, win over Saint Vincent on Oct. 31, Bova threw for 373 yards, coming within one yard of breaking his own program record for passing yardage in a game. In all, Bova completed 27-of-42 passes, threw for four touchdowns, and ran for a fifth.

Why Tomcats?

Through 1923 Thiel athletic teams were known as the "Huskies." But in 1924, greatly impressed by the spirit of the Thiel football team, Carnegie Tech (now Carnegie Mellon) head coach Wally Steffen observed that "they played like wild, wild cats".

This prompted Melvin A. Blair of the Greenville Record-Argus to report "Thiel played like Tom's cats," in reference to head coach Dr. Thomas Holleran, a Greenville dentist and former all-American at the University of Pittsburgh. Thereafter, the Thiel "Huskies" became known as the Thiel "Tomcats", a tribute to Dr. Holleran.

Around the PAC

The next-to-last week of PAC regular season football action on November 7 saw conference champion Thomas More (9-0) come back from a 10-7 halftime deficit to remain unbeaten with a 21-12 victory over visiting Geneva (7-2).

With the win, the 9-0 Saints now head to face fellow unbeaten local rival Mount St. Joseph (9-0) for the 2009 Bridge Bowl next Saturday (Nov. 14).

In other conference grid action, Washington & Jefferson (8-1, 4-1 PAC) kept its hopes for a 2009 NCAA Pool C playoff berth alive with a 49-0 road shutout at Bethany (2-7, 1-5 PAC).

Grove City (4-5, 3-2 PAC) moved into sole possession of third place in the conference, edging Westminster (3-6, 2-4 PAC) 38-31 on a last-minute touchdown.

Today's Honorary Captain

Today's honorary captain is Jack Leipheimer '74.

Leipheimer took over as Thiel College's Director of Athletics on Nov. 17, 2008. He currently oversees Thiel's 16 competitive athletics programs, 15 of which are associated with the NCAA at the Division III level.

A coaching veteran of 34 years – including 25 at the collegiate level - Leipheimer returned to Thiel as its head football coach in 2001 and promptly guided the program to national prominence. His 2005 team compiled an 11-1 record and drew two NCAA play-off games to Alumni Stadium.

Leipheimer was a four-year letter winner and three-year starter at tight end, earning All-PAC accolades in 1973. He was a member of the 1972 squad that registered the college's second PAC title with a 6-1 conference mark.

Jack and his wife, Patti, reside in Greenville. They have two grown daughters: Shanna and Krista.

ABOUT THE PRESIDENTS' ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

Founded in 1955, the Presidents' Athletic Conference continues its mission of promoting inter-collegiate athletics and the pursuit of academic excellence.

Comprised of 10 select private colleges - Bethany College, Chatham University, Geneva College, Grove City College, Saint Vincent College, Thiel College, Thomas More College, Washington and Jefferson College, Waynesburg University and Westminster College - the PAC remains a unique organization in this day of high pressure intercollegiate athletics. With academics at the center of each member's philosophy, the PAC is built on the principle that an athletic program is a part of college life, but not an entity in itself.

The PAC expanded to seven members in 2005 with the addition of Thomas More, formerly an NCAA Division III independent. Saint Vincent College, a former NAIA member, joined the conference as its began provisional membership status in NCAA Division III in 2006-07. Another former NAIA member, Geneva College, became the conference's ninth member and began league play as it started NCAA Division III provisional membership in 2007-08. Chatham College became the league's 10th member, also in 2007-08.

The PAC annually crowns champions in 19 sports. In 2008-09, the conference had 41 teams represent the conference in postseason play, including 23 in NCAA Championship events. PAC championship teams receive automatic qualification (AQ) status for most NCAA Division III national championship events.

All-conference status is awarded in all 19 sports. Head coaches select all-league squads for all team sports, while in individual sports such as cross country and tennis, all-PAC accolades are based upon performances at the conference championships.

The PAC annually awards its men's and women's All-Sports Trophies to the schools which perform best across the board in PAC competition. The Washington & Jefferson College men and Westminster College women captured the 2008-09 trophies.

True to its mission, the PAC has produced numerous Academic All-Americans and NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship winners. Last year, the league named 602 student-athletes to the PAC Academic Honor Roll, which recognizes all participating athletes who attain a term grade-point average of 3.60 or above.
